

## SSP/SGP conference in Geneva – 8 & 9 september 2015

### How to get to the conference

The conference takes place at the university building UniMail of the University of Geneva:

Université de Genève  
40 Boulevard du Pont-d'Arve  
1205 Genève, Switzerland

#### Coming from the airport:

Before leaving the baggage hall at Geneva airport, you can get a **free ticket** for public transport at the ticket machines next to the exits.

The train connection to the main station ("Gare Cornavin") only takes 7 minutes. Every train leaving from the airport stops at Geneva main station (first stop). You can also take the bus number 5 to the main station.

From there you can take the tram to go the conference venue.

<b>Option 1</b>	<b>~ 30 min total</b>
1. Take any train to Geneva main station Stop at the main station "Gare Cornavin"	~ 7 min
2. Take Tram 15 - direction "Palettes" Stop at "Uni Mail"	~ 15 min

<b>Option 2</b>	<b>~ 40 min total</b>
1. Take Bus 5 - direction "Thônex-Vallard", (or any other bus going to "Gare Cornavin") Stop at the main trainstation "Gare Cornavin"	~ 14 min
2. Take Tram 15 - direction "Palettes" Stop at "Uni Mail"	~ 15 min

#### Coming from the station:

Tram stop is located directly in front of the main entrance of Gare Cornavin. One single trip costs 3.00CHF / daily pass costs after 9:00 costs 8.00CHF.

At the hotel you usually get a free ticket for the time of your stay.

Take Tram 15 - direction "Palettes" Stop at "Uni Mail"	~ 15 min

It's the easiest to find directions using google maps or your trusted GPS.

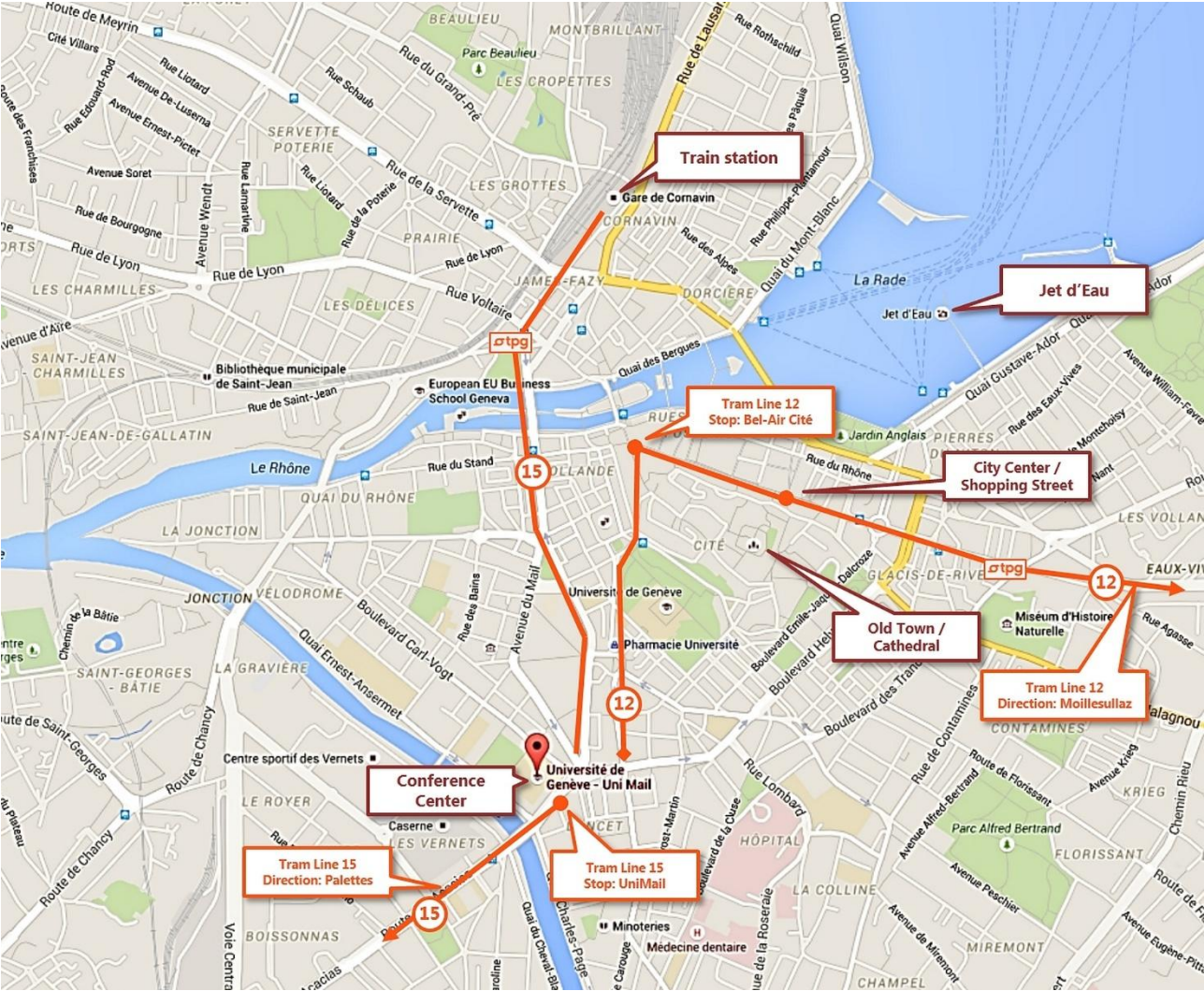
